Justification:

The congress is aimed to teach dermatologists, pathologists, oncologists, oncological surgeons, plastic surgeons, geriatrists, gynecologists, and oral pathologists about the process of aging and its cutaneous consequences.

Dermatopathology is the essential basis of the congress, thus 60% of the curricula will be dedicated to the dermatopathology of aging and the remaining 40% to items related with the clinical manifestations, dermoscopic findings and the available therapeutic modalities to treat cutaneous aging.

After the congress ends the attendee is expected to know and recognize the processes that unleash aging, the association of related diseases and the best therapeutic approach towards them

"From the microscope to therapeutics®" **Cutaneous aging:** changing the status quo

Objective:

The Second International Congress of Dermatopathology, "from the microscope to therapeutics®" is intended to address the subject of cutaneous aging and define its position in the present world.

The definition of disease has changed historically ⁽¹⁾. Some disorders that were considered as disease are no longer so, such as fever which is now considered as a symptom in several different diseases; or as some entities that are actually considered a normal part of the aging process like osteoporosis, arterial hypertension, Alzheimer's disease, rather than diseases themselves.⁽²⁾

Disease is considered a phenomenon with definitions in both social and biological contexts. Medically speaking, disease is considered as an anomaly of the structure or function of the body, more than the physical changes derived from it.⁽³⁾ The social aspect is more difficult to define, as we must consider the definition of health proposed by the WHO, where it is considered as the state of absolute physical, mental and social well-being, and not only the absence of disease. ⁽⁴⁾

Aging can be defined as the intrinsic process per se (primary aging) or as the diseases that occur as a result (secondary aging). For example, in dermatology, photoaging is considered to be the accelerated cutaneous deterioration secondary to the effect of ultraviolet radiation exposure through life and it is also considered to be a condition that leads to different pathological entities, like cancer. Considering aging as a disease allows to eliminate the term "natural" in the process and legitimizes the medical efforts to vanish the undesired conditions associated with it. Therefore, further research is needed to slow the process or limit the undesirable effects generated by aging.

Proceedings:

The congress will be divided in several modules: master lectures given by expert national and international professors, *symposiums*, and interactive *symposiums* with breakfast or box lunch provided.

The Master Lecture Modules will be taught by national or international professors that will address adnexal tumors, pigmented melanocytic lesions, soft tissue tumors, carcinomas, inflammatory disorders and photoaging per se.

Each conference will not be longer than 40 minutes and will be given in a concise and concrete way trying to up-rise the fundamentals of diagnosis, differential diagnosis and therapeutics, sparing some time for questions and answers.

The Symposium Modules will be the following:

- A. Trichology. This area is a developing niche, so it is of extreme importance that those who have dedicated their time, increase their knowledge in this area of dermatology, sharing with us the most common entities and their management.
- **B.** Oral Diseases. It is as important for the dermatologist or physician to be able to establish diagnosis, as it is to be able to use various treatments for different oral diseases. For this reason, we have requested the most experienced group to address inflammatory diseases, tumors and metastatic lesions.
- c. Mycotic Diseases. The goal of this symposium is to define common, and unusual entities with difficult diagnosis in geriatric patients, interacting in clinical cases, recognizing nail diseases associated or not to mycotic etiology and the long term consequences of systemic and subcutaneous mycosis.
- D. Genital Diseases in Geriatric Patients. Themes as general care of the skin in the elderly, vulvar pruritus, colposcopy and vaginal cytology, histopathological findings in genital pathology and vulvar revitalization will be addressed. These themes interest not only the dermatologist but also the geriatrists, gynecologists, and medical and surgical oncologists.
- E. Autoevaluation, "Dr. Clemente Alejandro Moreno Collado". This symposium proposes as a goal to expose the assistant in situ and in distance to the experience of defining entities in pure histopathological cases. It will promote clear and precise histopatological criteria and findings to acknowledge transcendent diagnosis in the geriatric population.
- F. Miscelaneous Topics in Aging: Vaccines, Contact Dermatitis, Pharmacodermias, Acne and Rosacea. In recent years these topics have been considered of utmost importance in Medicine, and much research is ongoing. Different entities that affect this population will be addressed since they are of interest to physicians.


